LIBRARY

The libraries of our college have been developed into real centers of learning. They contain the traditional collections of books, journals, periodicals and other printed materials besides audio, visual and electronic services. Students have access to library books and periodicals from 08.00 am to 08.00 pm. Electronic information service, media workshops and PC networks are also available in the library. It is kept open for over 80 hours in a week. The libraries are equipped with facilities to get online access. Moreover facilities to get access through our website have already been provided. Thus the students get total access in retrieving any information from the library.

DIGITAL LIBRARY

Digital library of NCERC is developed to meet the most advanced information requirement of the aca-

demical community and is fully automated with software for easy and fast access. The library has a collection of 42,000 odd books under different topics to meet the ever growing demand of the students and faculty in the field of science and technology. There are 322 international/national journals and periodicals besides there are educational CD's of about 3000 in the library. This library is acting as a nodal centre for all digitalized information. Online library with links to all the leading libraries and Universities in India and abroad is also available in our college.

INTERNET

NCERC is equipped with high speed lease line of 64 MBPS internet connectivity. This is done in order to enable the students to explore the widest range of information for their studies through internet.

DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

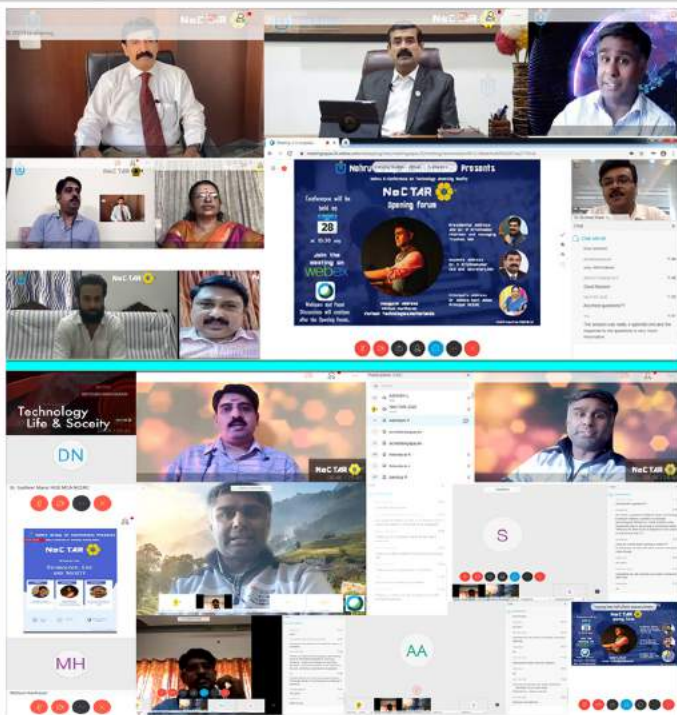

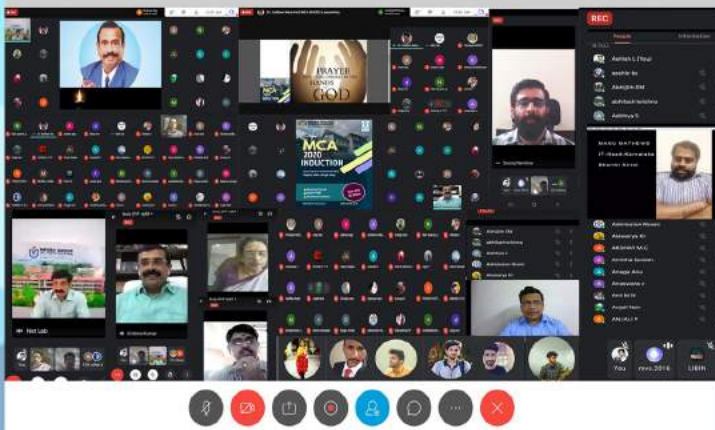

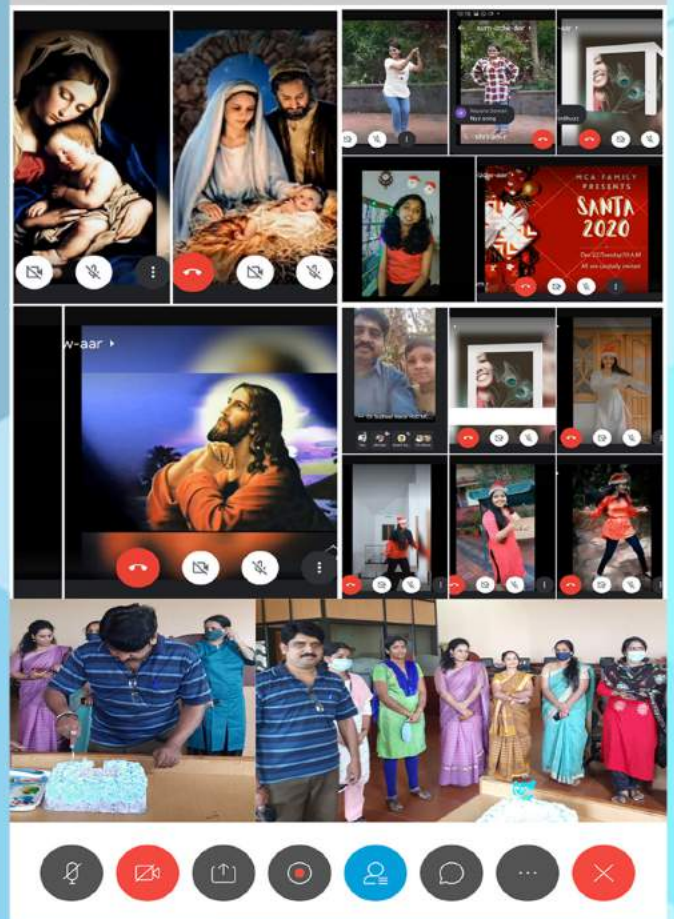

HALLS OF RESIDENCE @ NCERC & LIFE IN CAMPUS



The Halls of Residence of NCERC proudly boast of a range of excellent accommodation facilities available to every budget. We provide good food and courteous catering to suit every wallet. Staying at NCERC shall be an exhilarating experience. Especially if you are moving away from home for the first time. For the student choosing NCERC as a place of study, there are many advantages. The hostel surrounded with lush green vegetation is continuously swept and hugged by the gentle breeze that brings the purity, serenity and sweetness of nature. This picturesque location shall linger nostalgically in the minds of anybody staying in this beautiful area. Endowed with an enchanting and breathtaking topography, lush green natural vegetation, virgin land, pollution free atmosphere, equitable temperature, plentiful of nectar like sweet and fresh

water and salubrious climate, this is a sought after place for healthy life, clear thinking and for pleasant learning pursuits. Hostels are located close to the academic area and needs a short walk from all academic buildings and library. First year students are encouraged to stay in college hostels only. students will be provided double/triple room only. However, first year students who desire to have A/C rooms may reserve their names with chief warden at the time of counseling. Security guards are put on duty for 24 hours. The hostel provides a cot, a mattress, a study table, a chair and a cupboard for each student. Every hostel has uninterrupted electricity, solar heated water facility, water cooler, common telephone, common TV room, common reading room etc. Campus is having gymnasium and indoor games facilities.

Note- It is desirable that all students stay in the college Hostel. It is mandatory that all first year students desirous of staying outside under own arrangement must bring their parents in person and they must submit a request letter to the administration for necessary permission. The student must also bring their local Guardian and must give an undertaking about the student's welfare and security of the student. Also his/her ad-

dress and land line/ mobile numbers are to be registered with the office.

NCERC provide highly nutritious food prepared in ultra modern kitchens. The pleasant ambience in the dining area is another plus point. Several other facilities exist in our canteen / cafeteria/hostel.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Nativity

- The candidate must be an Indian **Citizen**. Certificate from a Village Officer or a competent authority showing that the candidate is a native of any State or Union Territory of India should be uploaded. True copies of the birth certificate issued by the competent authority/ passport/ school certificate-showing place of birth will also be accepted as proof of nativity.

Academic Eligibility

- Candidates should have passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree.

OR

- Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University).
- Candidates should have obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying examination.
- *No rounding off of percentage of marks to the nearest higher integer is permitted-*

Note: (1) Candidate seeking admission to the course should be qualified from any of the Universities in Kerala or any other Universities, recognized by any of the Universities in Kerala.

Note:(2) Final Year regular Bachelor's Degree students are also permitted to appear for the Entrance Examination subject to the condition that the original degree certificate and mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examination shall be produced by the candidate at the time of admission. Inclusion in the ranklist is provisional and subject to the academic eligibility conditions referred above.

CATEGORISATION OF SEATS

The seats available are mainly categorized as Government, Management and Lapsed seats.

- **(a)** Government seats are those seats against which allotment will be made by the Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology under the supervision of Director of Technical Education based on the rank list published by Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology.
- **(b)** Management seats are those seats set apart in Aided/Self-financing institutions to be filled up by the Management concerned on the basis of the Supreme Court direction and Government Orders on this behalf.
- **(c)** Lapsed seats are those seats that may be filled up by the institution itself before the closing of admissions and when the Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology intimates that he would not be allotting any more candidates after the scheduled allotment process against such seats.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Step 1 Get Prescribed application form from of the college by remitting the cost of it in cash or through DD.

Step 2 Send/Submit the duly filled application form along with the registration fee of Rs 1000/- incash or by DD along with original and one set attested copies of qualifying / eligibility certificates as given at (a) of Step 3.

Step 3 When the application is accepted by the College, the candidates should remit the prescribed fees to the college and the admission will be confirmed after verification of the Originals of the following documents:

- a) 1. SSLC Book and mark sheet or 10th Standard mark list and certificate.
 2. 10 + 2/equivalent certificate and mark sheet
 3. UG certificate and mark sheets (If applicable)
 4. Diploma certificate (If applicable)
 5. Transfer certificate
 6. Conduct certificate
 7. Community certificate (If applicable)
 8. Medical fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner
 9. Entrance rank certificate and entrance marks card (if applicable)
 10. Migration certificate (if applicable)
 11. NRI status certificate (if applicable)
- b) 1. Four numbers of passport size colour photo graphs
 2. Two numbers of stamp size colour photographs
 3. Copy of fee receipt paid for the admission

Note :

- a) The College has the right to cancel the admission made if any of the certificates submitted is found to be false or tampered with or the qualification of the candidate admitted is not approved by the University.
- b) All the certificates/documents to be produced for admission shall be attested by the gazetted officer/head of the institution where the student had studied.

DOCUMENTS (IN ORIGINAL) TO BE PRODUCED AT **THE TIME OF ADMISSION**

1. Admit Card of the Entrance Examination.
2. Allotment Memo and Fee receipt.
3. SSLC or any relevant school records to prove date of birth.
4. Originals of Degree Certificate and Mark list of all parts of the qualifying exam.
5. Originals of Certificates, the copies of which are enclosed with the print out of application form.
6. Transfer certificate and conduct certificate from the institution where the candidate studied last.
7. Two copies of passport size photograph of the candidate.
8. Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce “Eligibility Certificate / Equivalency Certificate” from any of the Universities in Kerala.
9. Applicant who is employed or a trainee in Government service, Scheduled Bank etc. should produce, at the time of interview, a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the office where the applicant is employed.
10. The student who qualifies from other universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.

Note: All certificates as listed above must be produced for verification at the time of admission. Candidates will not be given any chance to produce the original documents/certificates asked for, on a subsequent occasion.
